

OPEN CAMPUS

At the beginning of the school year, the County Superintendent of Schools or designee shall notify parents/guardians about the open campus policy as required by law. (Education Code 44808.5)

The County Superintendent, County Board members and County Office employees shall not be liable for the conduct and safety of students who leave school grounds during the lunch period. (Education Code 44808.5)

The principal of each high school shall be responsible for the annual preparation, implementation and evaluation of the school's open campus program.

The site principal may revoke the open campus privilege to any or all students at any time. The site principal shall submit a report to the Superintendent or designee indicating the nature and scope of the problem and a procedure for reviewing and resolving the problem.

The County Superintendent shall notify the County Board of any campus closure.
