INFECTIOUS DISEASE CONTROL

SP 4122.00

The County Superintendent is committed to maintaining a safe, healthful environment for all employees. The County Superintendent or designee shall provide County Office of Education staff with information responding to concerns about workplace safety and explaining ways by which various infectious diseases are known to be transmitted.

In keeping with the Health and Safety Code, the County Office of Education shall distribute to its employees information about AIDS, AIDS-related conditions, and Hepatitis B as such information is compiled and updated by the California State Department of Education. The information shall describe ways to prevent exposure to those diseases, including the availability of a vaccine to prevent contraction of Hepatitis B. Employees shall be informed as to whether the cost of vaccination is covered by the health plan. (Health and Safety Codes 199.81-199.82)

Because medical knowledge about infectious diseases is continually growing, this policy shall be reviewed annually and updated when necessary.
