

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AND DESIGN

The County Board of Education and County Superintendent of Schools shall provide an instructional program to serve the educational needs of the County Office of Education students. The County Board shall adopt and the County Superintendent shall implement a curriculum that meets the requirements of law and reflects the desires of the community.

The County Superintendent or designee shall develop a process for curriculum review and development that may include the participation of teachers, administrators and parents/guardians. The curriculum is then submitted to the County Board for approval.

Curriculum development and design shall be consistent with the philosophy, goals and objectives of the County Office of Education. The selection and evaluation of the instructional materials shall be coordinated with the process for curriculum development.

The County Superintendent or designee shall keep the County Board informed regarding current curriculum efforts. The County Superintendent or designee shall provide all necessary assistance to the County Board in reviewing reports, information and data on each curriculum area for evaluation and adoption by the County Board.

The County Board shall review this policy and implement regulations annually.
