## **TOBACCO-FREE SCHOOLS/SMOKING**

## **Tobacco-Free Schools**

Ample research has demonstrated the health hazards associated with the use of tobacco products, including smoking and the breathing of second-hand smoke.

As role models, County Office of Education employees should demonstrate conduct that is consistent with school programs to discourage students from using tobacco products.

Therefore, the County Board of Education believes it is in the best interests of students, employees and the general public to prohibit the use of products containing tobacco and/or nicotine, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, miniature cigars, smokeless tobacco, snuff, chew, clove cigarettes, betel, electronic cigarettes, electronic hookah, and other vapor-emitting devices, with or without nicotine content, that mimic the use of tobacco products, are also prohibited, any time, in MCOE-owned or leased buildings, on MCOE property and in MCOE vehicles.

This section does not prohibit the use or possession of prescription products, or other cessation aids such as nicotine patches or nicotine gum. Student use or possession of such products must conform to laws governing student use and possession of medications on school property.
