Personnel

WEAPONS AND DANGEROUS INSTRUMENTS

The County Superintendent of Schools prohibits students, employees and the public from carrying on their person, or in any vehicle, weapons, imitation firearms or dangerous instruments of any kind while on Mendocino County Office of Education (MCOE) property (grounds, buildings, classrooms, vehicles, etc.), or at an MCOE/school event, except as provided by law.

Under the power granted to the County Superintendent to maintain order and protect the safety of students, staff and the public, any employee is authorized to confiscate a weapon, dangerous instrument or imitation firearm from any person on MCOE property or involved in an MCOE/school event.

Any individual possessing, selling, furnishing, or threatening others with a firearm or similar weapon, dangerous instrument or imitation firearm at MCOE or at an MCOE/school event shall be reported in accordance with the law. (20 USC 8922, Education Code Section 48902, Penal Code 245, 626.9, 626.10)
