EMERGENCIES AND DISASTER PREPAREDNESS PLAN

It is recognized that pursuant to legal requirements the County Superintendent of Schools or designee shall develop and maintain a disaster preparedness plan that details provisions for handling all foreseeable emergencies and disasters, including earthquakes. This plan shall be reviewed and updated at least annually.
