Instruction

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Mendocino County Board of Education shall establish prescribed courses of study for a *Diploma of Graduation from High School*. Students shall receive a Diploma upon satisfactory completion of the appropriate course(s) of study with a minimum completion of 180 units.

The prescribed courses of study for students in grades 9 through 12 shall consist of: (Education Code 51225.3)

- 1. Four (4) years of English
- 2. Two (2) years of mathematics, including one year of Algebra (Education Code Section 51224.5)
- 3. Two (2) years of science, including life/physical sciences
- 4. Three (3) years of Social Studies, including United States History and Geography; World History, Culture and Geography; American Government Civics, and Economics
- 5. One (1) year of Applied/Fine Arts, including visual or performing arts, or foreign language or American Sign Language
- 6. Two (2) years of Physical Education, unless the student has been exempted pursuant to Education Code provisions
- 7. Elective courses of study, 40 Credits.

The satisfactory completion of the above courses shall be determined by a letter grade of A, B, C, or D.

The County Board may adopt alternative means for the completion of a course of study for a Diploma which may include:

- 1. Career Technical Education classes offered in high schools
- 2. Independent Study
- 3. Credit earned at a postsecondary institution
- 4. Credit for driver education, which satisfies the requirement of Vehicle Code 12507
